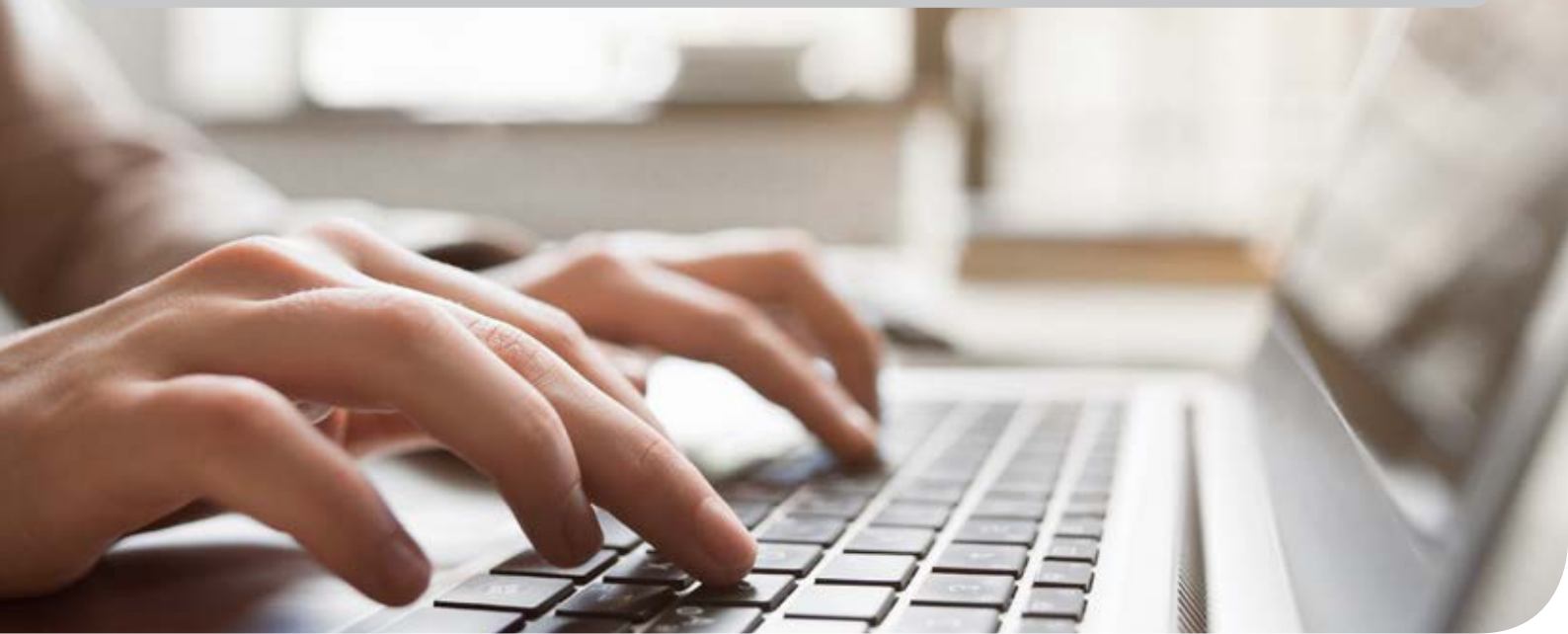

The course is suited to students who are currently enrolled or have completed a Diploma or Advanced Diploma of Accounting or higher qualification. The course provides students with the knowledge and competencies covering:

- Preparation administration of tax documents for individuals and legal entities,
- Implementation and commercial law.
